<b><u>Request for designated/protected sidewalk &amp; cycle path between Ocean View &amp; Kommetjie</u></b>	
<p>The residents of both Communities have to use the road because there is not a suitably paved sidewalk for recreational purposes when they go to the beach, to school, go home or when they commute between both communities to earn a living. They walk, cycle, skateboard, push trolleys along the roads, go by wheelchair or push prams.</p> <p>These are vulnerable road users (VRU), and they deserve their own designated, separated sidewalk which is protected from vehicles</p> <p>There have been many crashes resulting in deaths or injuries to these VRU in the past.</p> <p>A peaceful demonstration was held recently by Ocean View and Kommetjie residents, where it was reported that Cllr Simon Liell-Cock had been requesting this sidewalk for 10 years.
